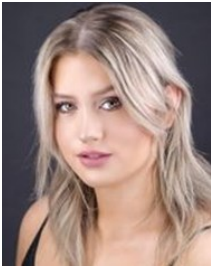


WHO IS WHO

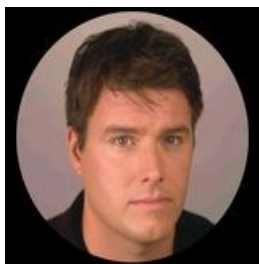

Susan O'Brien (Narrator/Phantom) thanks you for supporting local theatre and joining us on this "strange journey"!

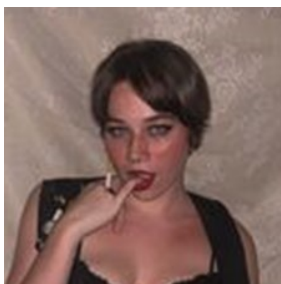
